

AT MICKEY, EVERY PAINTING IS A MASTERPIECE.



Mickey's computer-controlled painting system is totally immune to weather conditions, dust, dirt and other contaminants, ensuring the best looking, most durable paint job in the body and trailer manufacturing industry.

STATION 1: Alunalux washing and etching, hot water rinse, bonding application to ensure proper paint adhesion.

STATION 2: Unit is "baked dry" with 170-degree air blown at 1,200 CFM. Completely removes all moisture.

STATION 3: Mickey technicians manually mask all unpainted areas.

STATION 4: Primer coat is applied and unit is "flash-dried."

STATION 5: Top coat is applied via computer-controlled pre-mix paint guns with multi-color capabilities.

STATION 6: "Baking Oven" dries finish completely with 140-degree air at 750 CFM.
